

GCC Governments are committing to make at least 10% of its new fleets electric or hybrid. With Government efforts towards providing driverless transportation solutions, RTA recently announced plans to make up to 25 per cent of all transport journeys in Dubai autonomous by 2030.

Car ownership in the region is growing fast. As employment and education attract more commuters to towns and suburbs, demand is outweighing supply. Gulf Parking explores innovative solutions to enable the region to meet demand efficiently and intelligently.

THE REGION'S DECISION MAKERS

The Gulf region is forging ahead with plans to improve its transportation infrastructure with \$121.3 billion worth of road and bridge projects already underway or in the planning phase. Nearly half of the regional spend is concentrated in the UAE, which has \$58 billion worth of road and bridge investments planned.

Saudi Arabia is the next largest spender on road and bridge infrastructure pledging \$26.9 billion to upgrade the country's transport infrastructure over the next five years.

Identifying the importance of UAE's planned expenditure, Gulf Traffic is held in partnership with the UAE's Ministry of Infrastructure Development (MoID). Each year, government representatives are on hand to talk about current and future tenders, projects and innovations.

In addition, key Government and Municipality representatives from the entire region play an important role at Gulf Traffic including the RTA, DMAT, Ministry of Interior (UAE, Qatar, Kuwait), Sharjah RTA, Traffic Police Saudi Arabia, Dubai Police, Abu Dhabi Police, Emirates Transport Authority, Ministry of Transport Oman and Ministry of Transport Saudi Arabia.

There are multiple opportunities to meet and network with these key decision makers during the event either by visiting the GCC Transport and Municipality Authorities stand or by attending one of many networking events.

EDUCATING THE INDUSTRY

The Gulf Traffic Conference has provided a yearly platform for the most innovative thought-leaders to convene in a high-level discussion on the future of traffic in the region.

This means that researchers need to get their publications cited in the work of others and debated in traditional and online media. In order to achieve a greater scholarly and public impact, researchers must promote their work as much as possible.

To fulfill this goal, Gulf Traffic 2017 has partnered with JTTM and organized a special issue on "Advance Technologies for Traffic Management & Urban Mobility (AT-TMUM)". Including all new theoretical and experimental findings in the field of traffic management, urban mobility, road safety, intelligent transport systems, ride-sharing, intelligent parking, and smart transport applications.

International Journal of Traffic and Transportation Management (JTTM) is a refereed international journal to be of interest and use to all those concerned with research in various fields of ubiquitous systems. JTTM aims to provide a highly readable and valuable addition to the literature which will serve as an indispensable reference tool for years to come. The journal also encourages the submission of critical review articles covering advances in recent research of such fields as well as technical notes. It is published by the International Association for Sharing Knowledge and Sustainability (IASKS).

An impressive stage in the E-Mobility Zone will attract audiences and give automotive brands the opportunity to tell the world about their smart solutions.


